- If unsure, refer to the sample codes and look up the references for C++ STL.

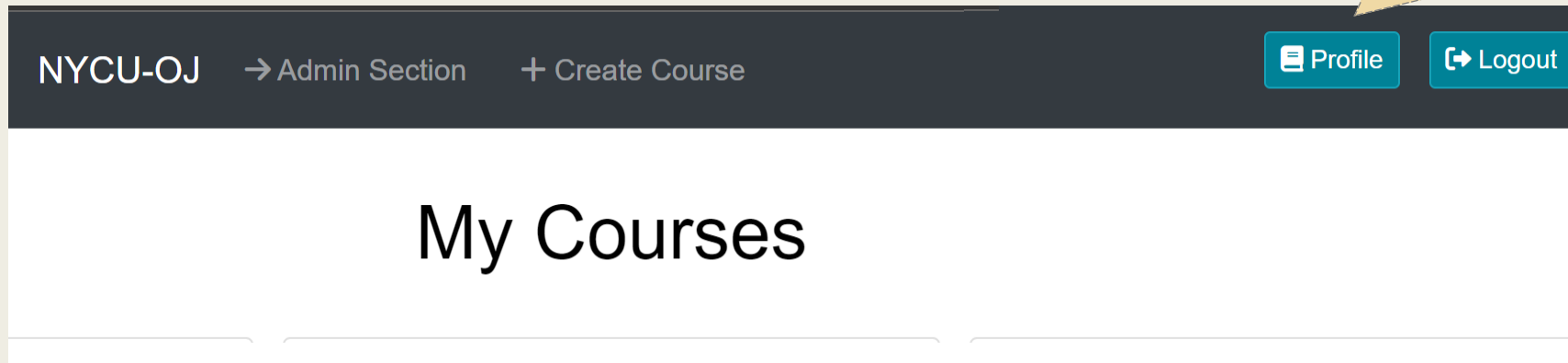
Notes - II
